Comments / Explanations:

Rider E Byrne-Burke was examined by the club doctor and Medical Edge staff after the completion of Race 6 and was stood down for the remainder of the meeting due to being dehydrated. Rider E Byrne Burke was advised she will require a medical clearance prior to riding again.

RACE 1 – BOOK NOW FOR THE LADBROKES PUNTERS MARQUEE 3YO & UPWARDS MAIDEN (1120 METRES)

CARDIOSPHERE – Raced wide in the early stages.

TROTSKY – Under-went a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed suitable to start.

RAPIDS AHEAD – Declared a late scratching at 6.08pm after becoming cast under the front of the barriers. Trainer G McCulloch was advised that the gelding must complete a satisfactory trial prior to racing again. Trainer G McCulloch advised stewards that it is intentions to now spell the gelding prior to trialling. A post-race veterinary examination revealed lacerations to the right foreleg. Trainer G McCulloch was advised that a veterinary certificate is required prior to the geldings next trial or race start. On the announcement of correct weight Stewards ordered that all monies invested on RAPIDS AHEAD be refunded, with the following deductions to apply to all successful wagers placed prior to 6.08pm.

Stewards ordered that the following deductions would apply:

HEART OF PARIS – Warning placed on the mare for being fractious in the barriers prior to the start.

TAKEAWAY – Rider K Boxall reported that there was something a miss with the mare when returning to scale. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

LADY FERN – Rider C Wells advised stewards that when placing the filly under pressure that it failed to respond to her riding. Under-went a post-race veterinary examination and no obvious abnormalities were detected.

MARGIE – Under-went a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed suitable to start. Shifted out under pressure in the home straight.

SMART ARTIE – Raced wide throughout.

RACE 2 – GALLOPING GOURMET TOUR HEADING TO STANLEY 3YO & UPWARDS MAIDEN (1420 METRES)

CORNICKS ROAD – Raced wide throughout

GEMS EAGLE – Began awkwardly, steadied off heels of ROLLING IN IT when over racing at about the 800 metres and then bumps with ARGYLL DIAMOND. Bumps with ARGYLL DIAMOND at about the 900 metres.

HIGH TAIL EAGLE – Restrained off heels shortly after the start.

WANNABE ZIGGY – Bumped with NIGHTCLUBBING at the start. Lost an off-hind plate in the run. A post-race veterinary examination revealed small laceration to the off-hind coronet.

ARGYLL DIAMOND – Bumped with GEMS EAGLE at about the 800 metres turn and bumped again with GEMS EAGLE about the 900 metres. Raced greenly early stages.

FLORENCE GLASS – Restrained by its rider at about the 1200 metres.

LAST TREMBLE – A warning was placed on the filly's loading manners. Raced wide throughout.

SOUTH GEORGIA – Jumped inwards at the start, raced greenly throughout.

RACE 3 - LADBROKES OUTDOOR ENCLOSURE CUP DAY CLASS 1 HANDICAP (1420 METRES)

KAKIA – Raced wide throughout. Brushed with SPEED ROCK on a number of occasions over the final 100 metres.

BUNKER BOB – Raced fiercely early stages.

RED FOX – Slow to begin, raced wide throughout.

OCEAN EYES – Stewards granted permission for rider K Sanderson to ride 1/2kg over the allotted weight.

OZTURK – Raced wide throughout.

SPEED ROCK – Held up for a clear for a major part of the home straight. Brushed on a number of occasions with KAKIA inside the final 100 metres.

SYRUP - Bounded out at the start.

RACE 4 – TASMANIAN OAKS NIGHT OUTDOOR PARTY ON THE LEGER 0 – 62 RATING (1420 METRES)

GEE GEES ME BOY – Checked at the start when APRIL'S DANCE jumped outwards and AGNET jumped inwards.

SISTINE – Raced wide early.

AGNETE – Began awkwardly and jumped inwards tightening the run of GEE GEES ME BOY.

RODERICK'S SECRET – Re-saddled behind the barriers prior to the start. Rider J Radley dropped his whip at about the 200 metres. Stewards advised rider J Radley in the presence of senior rider K Sanderson, to ensure he is fully clear when shifting ground to improve when shifting out on the home turn brushing with GEE GEES ME BOY.

APRIL'S DANCE – Began awkwardly jumped outwards tightening the run of GEE GEES ME BOY. Over raced early stages of the race.

RACE 5 - LADBROKES FORM GENIUS CLASS 3 (1220 METRES)

DOONICAN – Slow to begin.

BELPINE MISS – Began awkwardly, slow to muster early speed. Raced wide throughout.

GOLDEN MEADOW – Over raced middle stages.

NGAPALI BEACH – Made the turn at the 800 metres awkwardly shifted out and got its head up.

UNIQUE EAGLE – A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 6 – KEVIN SHARKIE TASMANIAN OAKS FRIDAY NIGHT 21ST FEBRUARY BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP (2150 METRES)

BLONDE STAR – Declared a late scratching at 12.20pm on veterinary advise on advice from the trainer that the mare was showing signs of colic. Trainer I Miller was advised that a veterinary certificate is required prior to trialling or racing again.

On the announcement of correct weight Stewards ordered that all monies invested on BLONDE STAR be refunded, with the following deductions to apply to all successful wagers placed prior to 12.20pm.

MONTE FLEUR – Tightened at the start when KABOOM KABOOM shifted in and BULBUK shifted out.

BULBUK (GB) – Began awkwardly.

RACE 7 - NATIONAL PONY RACING SERIES FRIDAY NIGHT FEBRUARY BENCHMARK 76 HANDICAP (1620 METRES)

ALPINE AFFAIR – Slow to begin.

ARTY LUCAS – Slow to begin, threw its head up in the air and was restrained off heels at about the 700 metres.

OLE OLA – Raced fiercely got its head up and over raced early stages.

RACE 8 – LADBROKES LAUNCESTON CUP WEDNESDAY 26TH FEBRUARY MAIDEN/CLASS 1 (2150 METRES)

PIPING WILLOW – Over raced early stages.

ALPINE TROUT - Began awkwardly.

TIDEFORD (NZ) - Raced wide throughout.

GRANITE LEGEND – Rider M Ulucinar on returning to scale advised stewards that in his opinion that there was something amiss with the gelding and eased his mount down in the home straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

KASIHKU – Trainer M Trinder advised stewards that it is their intentions to have the mare ridden further circumstances permitting.
