Comments / Explanations:**RACE 1 – KEVIN SHARKIE 3YO & UPWARDS MAIDEN - (1200 METRES)**

FREDDY'SAJETSTAR – Raced wide throughout.

GEEGEE'S BIG BIRD – Reared on jumping and was slow to muster early speed.

DAD SAID YES – Jumped outwards at the start and was slow to muster early speed.

LIGHT FORCE – Raced three wide to the 600 metres. Shifted in abruptly at about the 200 metres when being placed under pressure with the whip in onto the heels of TALK SOON.

I'VE BEEN DREAMING – Began awkwardly brushing the outside barrier partition and shifted out abruptly.

PUZZLE MISS – Raced wide throughout, over raced early stages.

TALK SOON – Began awkwardly and over raced early stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

TOSEN FAME – Raced three wide throughout.

WHISPER OF MATILDA – Held up rounding the home turn until about the 200 metres.

MISS TINA – A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 2 – LADBROKES BLACKBOOK CLASS 5 HANDICAP – (1400 METRES)

JUST A NEEDS – Over raced early stages.

SWEET LUCIFER – Over raced early stages.

GEEGEE'S CITY BOY – Stewards granted permission for rider K Sanderson to ride 1/2 kg over the allotted weight. Rider K Sanderson was restricted in using his whip due to JUST A NEEDS racing tightly to his outside.

ASHFALL – Began awkwardly and was slow to muster early speed. Steadied off the heels of STARDARMUS at about the 1000 metres when POP A HONDA shifted in.

POP A HONDA – Raced three wide early. Shifted in at about the 1000 metres when not fully clear. Rider H Le Blanc was advised to ensure she is fully clear when shifting ground in similar circumstances.

RACE 3 – KEVIN SHARKIE ELWICK STAKES - (1100 METRES)

PRINCE OF KHATUN – Began awkwardly, shifted out and bumped with BELLA CHINKARA, raced wide to the 600 metres.

KWAZULU BENNY – Began awkwardly.

WOLF JUNIOR – Began awkwardly.

ZAMBEZI BLONDE – Slow to muster early speed, over raced early and middle stages.

BELLA CHINKARA – Bumped by PRINCE OF KHATUN at the start.

CRACK THE SHUTTERS – Bounded out at the start, carried in shortly after the start and commenced to over race. Held up for a clear run entering the home straight.

RACE 4 – GEARD FAMILY BLACKFLASH – (1100 METRES)

MS TASMANIA – Stewards advised rider T Baker of his obligations when shifting ground in the home straight, when carrying SKY EAGLE wider.

HIGHLAND DUEL – Stewards granted permission for rider C Newitt to ride 1/2kg over the allotted weight. Raced three wide throughout.

ANGEL SPHERE – Stewards granted permission for ride M Ulucinar to ride 1/2kg over the allotted weight. Splayed front feet losing its footing at the start and was slow to begin.

FIRST LINE – Stewards granted permission for rider S Foley to ride 1/2kg over the allotted weight.

TRANSOM – Tightened and checked approaching the 600 metres when receiving pressure from DYNAMIC WARRIOR to its outside.

SKY EAGLE – Stewards granted permission for rider D Pires to ride 1kg over the allotted minimum weight.

VOSTOK STATION – Slow to begin.

Stewards found rider J Radley (DYNAMIC WARRIOR) guilty of careless riding under the provisions of AR131(a). The particulars of the charge are that approaching the 600 metres he allowed his mount to shift in when not fully clear resulting in his mount laying in on TRANSOM for some distance making contact on a number of occasions, resulting in rider E Byrne Burke (TRANSOM) having to check her mount and lose her rightful running. In considering penalty stewards took into account his plea, his record under this rule and that the interference was in the mid-range. Rider J Radley's licence to ride in races was suspended for two Tasmanian race dates, commencing midnight 26th January, 2025 and expiring midnight the 7th February, 2025. Rider J Radley was advised of his right of appeal.

RACE 5 – WINNING EDGE PRESENTATIONS LADY LYNETTE – (1100 METRES)

MAWALLOCK – Began awkwardly, threw its head in the air and was slow to muster early speed.

GEE GEE ENUF SPEED – Raced wide throughout.

ARUMA – Fractious in the barriers prior to the start.

INTISAR – Slow to muster early speed.

PERIWINKLE – Raced wide the 600 metres.

PEROLA – Held up momentarily when rounding the home turn. Shifted out to improve entering the home straight.

RACE 6 – WINNING EDGE PRESENTATIONS THOUSAND GUINEAS – (1600 METRES)

AZONTO – Raced wide throughout.

NATIVE CLAN – Raced three wide throughout.

GO JEANIE – Raced wide throughout.

SILVER DAGGER – Slow to begin.

BAYBOUGG – Over raced early stages.

SNOW EAGLE – Over raced early stages.

ROYAL SCENE – Slow to begin and over raced early stages.

RACE 7 – AVISO TAS INSURANCE BROKERS SUMMER CUP – (2200 METRES)

ASHY BOY – Began awkwardly, raced wide cover throughout.

STRAWBERRY ROCK (IRE) – Stewards granted permission for trainer C Maher to lodge a late gear change with the addition of Blinkers.

PROMISES KEPT – Began awkwardly and bumped with KALIUWAA FALLS (NZ) soon after.

KALIUWAA FALLS (NZ) – Bumped with PROMISES KEPT at the start. Rider B Muhcu dropped his whip at about the 100 metres.

TRAVELLING GIGOLO – Raced wide with cover throughout.

METAVVERSE – A post-race veterinary examination found that the gelding was lame in the off fore. Trainer A Brakey was advised a veterinary certificate will be required prior to trialling or racing again.

ALWAYS A WINNER – Reared on jumping.

HAPPY CLAN – Fractious in barriers prior to the start.

DANTES (NZ) – Raced wide with cover throughout.

PENNINE – Began awkwardly.

DISTRUSTFUL AWARD – Restrained after the start to obtain a position closer to the rail.

FIORANTE DE LEGEND – Raced wide throughout.

RACE 8 – LADBROKES RACING CLUB BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP – (1100 METRES)

ALPINE THUNDER – Over raced early stages.

WINNING WITNESS – Under-went a pre-race veterinary examination after getting its head under the front of the barriers and was subsequently pass suitable to start. Jumped in at out at the start and bumped with BELLASARIO. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

BELLASARIO – Fractious prior to the start, slow to begin.

SHALL WE PLAY – Raced wide throughout.
